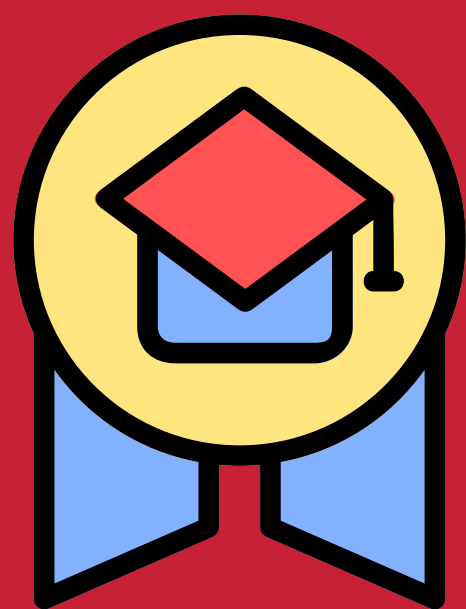
Australia is home to 43 universities in total, with 40 Australian, two international and one private university

PRIVATE COLLEGES IN AUSTRALIA



Independent colleges offer Bachelor's as well as Master's programs usually in the IT & Business fields



Some colleges are affiliated with universities (UG / PG programs)



Colleges also offer pathway programs such as ELICOS and Diploma, leading to Degree programs
Usually offered in fields of IT, Engineering, Health, Business, etc

UNIVERSITIES IN AUSTRALIA



BACHELORS (3- 5 YEARS)

- 12 Years of full-time education
- 60-65% or above in grade 12
- IELTS - 6.5
- PTE: 60+ is considered a good score



MASTERS (1-2 YEARS)

- 16 Years of full-time education
- 60-65% or above in grade 12
- GPA of 3 or above out of 4
- IELTS - 6.5, PTE: 60+ is considered a good score

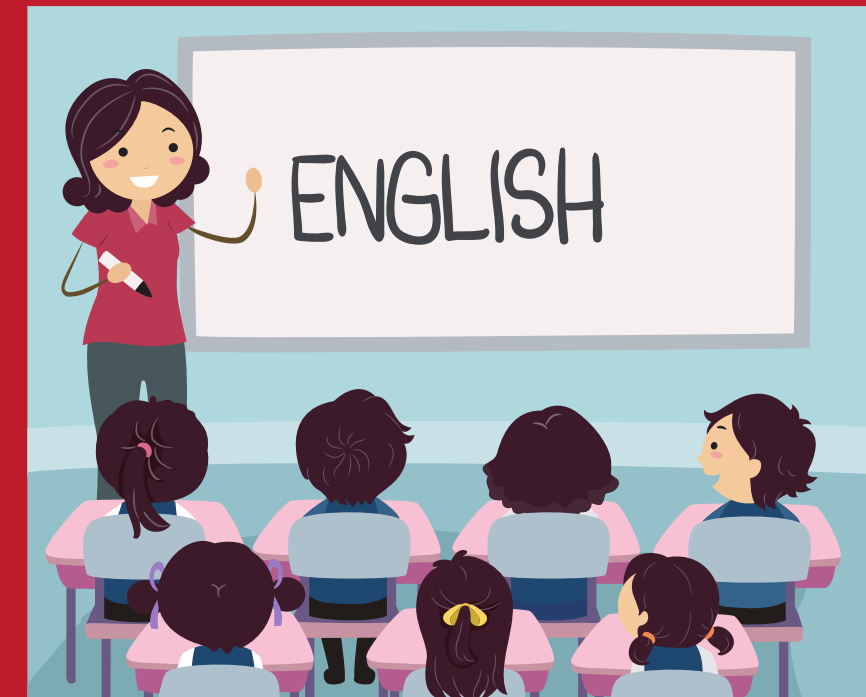


PATHWAY PROGRAMS IN AUSTRALIA



ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

- Students scoring 55%–64% in HSC
- Diploma leading to degree programs
- After completion of Diploma, students progress to the 2nd year of Bachelor's
- For PG, PQPs are offered by some universities



ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAMS

- ELICOS is for students that fall short of English Language requirements
- Students study English before program commencement
- 10 week duration
- Fees are AUD 300–AUD400 per week



TAFE - TECHNICAL AND FURTHER EDUCATION



TAFE is the biggest training and vocational education provider with more than 3,800 international students enrolling every year



Offers courses and short courses with qualifications from certificates to Diploma and Advanced Diploma level.



TAFE NSW is also registered as a higher education provider and offers degree level programs



It is Australia's largest vocational education and training provider based in New South Wales

Australia's manufacturing industry is well-known for innovative products, the industry accounts for about 48% of exports.



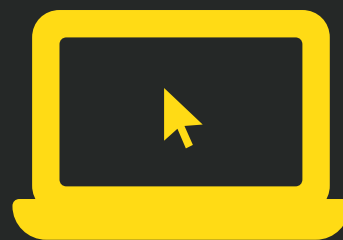
CONSTRUCTION

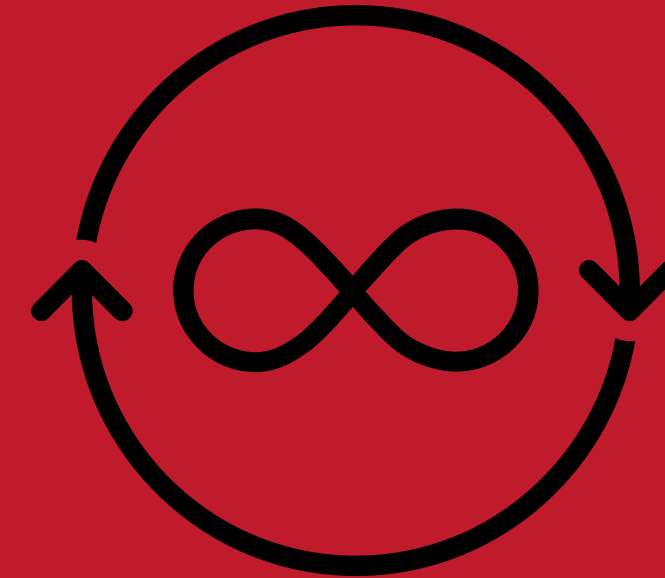
WORK WHILE STUDYING IN AUSTRALIA



PART TIME WORK - TERM

40 hours every 2 weeks

Part Time jobs available in supermarkets, convenience stores, Event management companies.



FULL TIME WORK - HOLIDAY TIME

During holiday time, you can work without any specific restrictions



POST STUDY WORK PERMIT

- Introduced on 16th November 2019, the new visa allows post-study work rights for international students up to 4 years in regional Australia
- Student should have a degree from a CRICOS-registered course

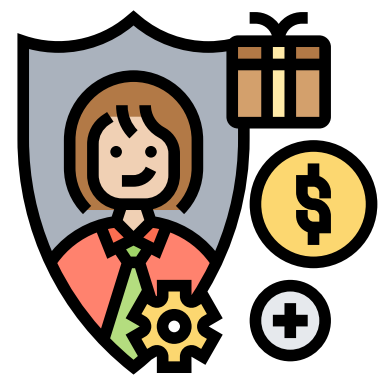

Incentives for students

Regular 2 years post study work visa for international students completing Bachelors and Masters degrees (minimum 92 weeks), 3 years for Masters by Research and 4 years for PhD. graduates

International students studying at regional universities will be eligible to access an additional year in Australia on a post-study work visa
(Which means a Bachelors or Masters graduate can get up to 3 years of PSW visa)

International students studying at regional universities will be eligible to access an additional 2 years in Australia on a post-study work visa
(Which means a Bachelors or Masters graduate can get up to 4 years of PSW visa)

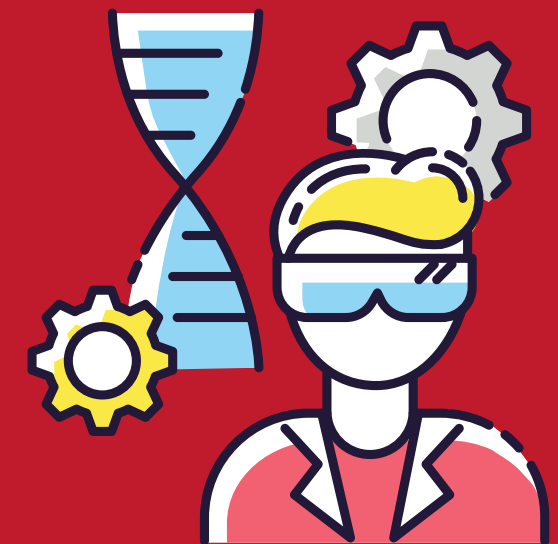

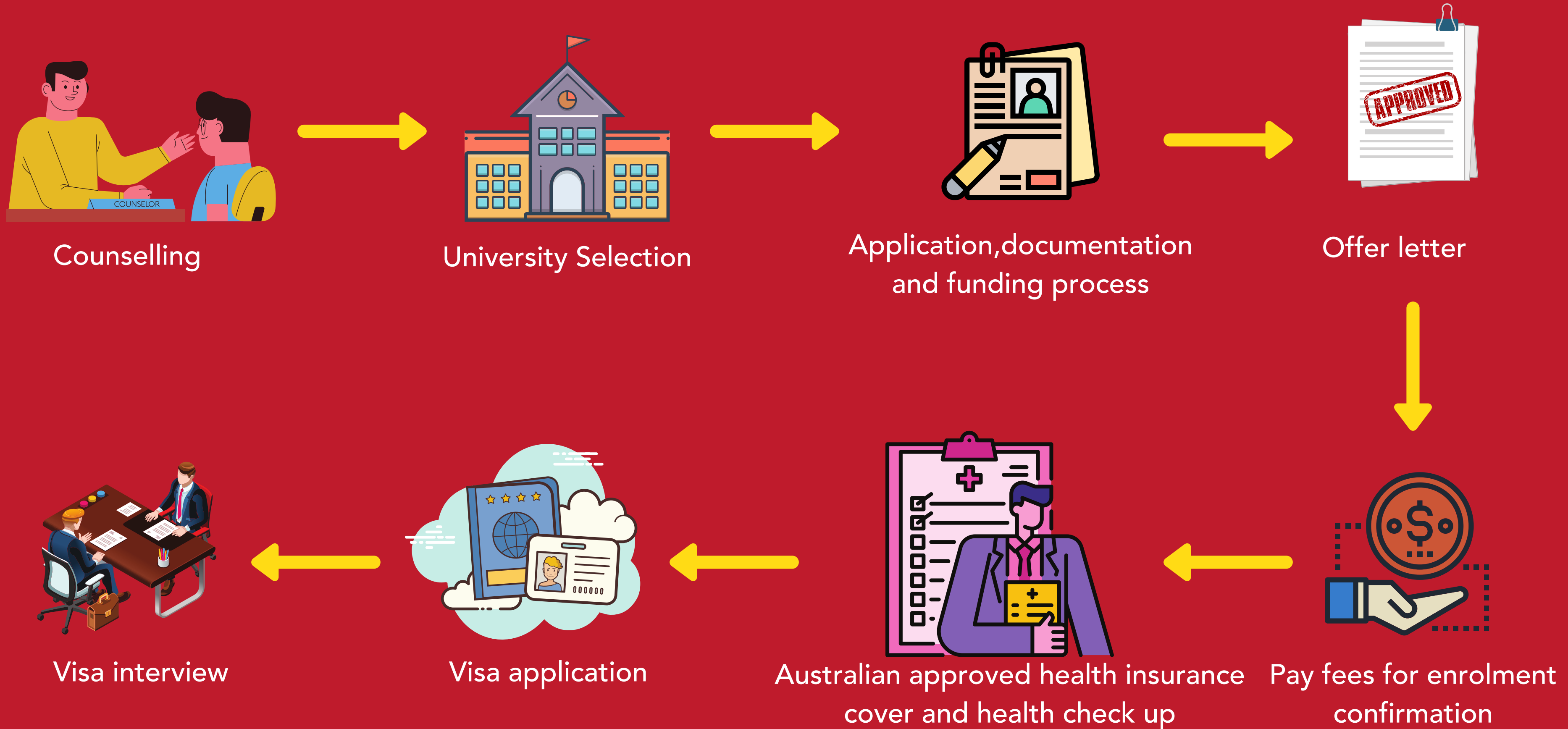

AUSTRALIA APPLICATION PROCESS FLOW



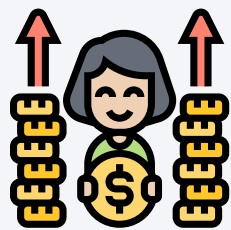
AVERAGE EXPENSE PER YEAR

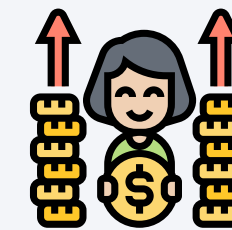

FINANCIALS AND VISAS IN AUSTRALIA

Acceptable fund sources

Educations loans, balance in Savings Accounts, Fixed Deposits

Acceptable sponsors

Parents, Grandparents, Siblings, Student him/herself, Uncle/Aunt [not more than 25%]

Education Loans

Should be from an acceptable institution and should be FULLY sanctioned and not 'in principle' or 'conditional'

Savings A/C & Deposits

Account statement covering transactions for the last 3-6 months

Income proofs

Income proofs for the recent 2-3 assessment years

Pre-medical test

Students have to medical tests after submitting their visa documents to the Australian High Commission from an 'empaneled' Physician/Clinic

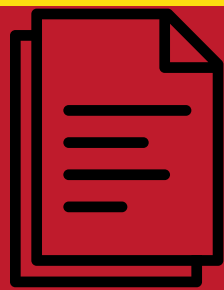


FINANCIALS AND VISAS IN AUSTRALIA

University Level approvals

Australian Universities may ask for sources of funds even if the funds are 3 months old

For Fixed Deposits with major amounts, the volume of funds deposited are matched with the annual income of sponsors. If they are not commensurate, then sources of deposits will be asked for.



Receiving financial documents and verifying

Verification by University

Interview (depending on university)

Fee payment approval & eCoE application

Visa outcome to be declared by the embassy

Health checkup do be done by student

Visa summary and details to be shared with student

Submission of visa docs and verification
