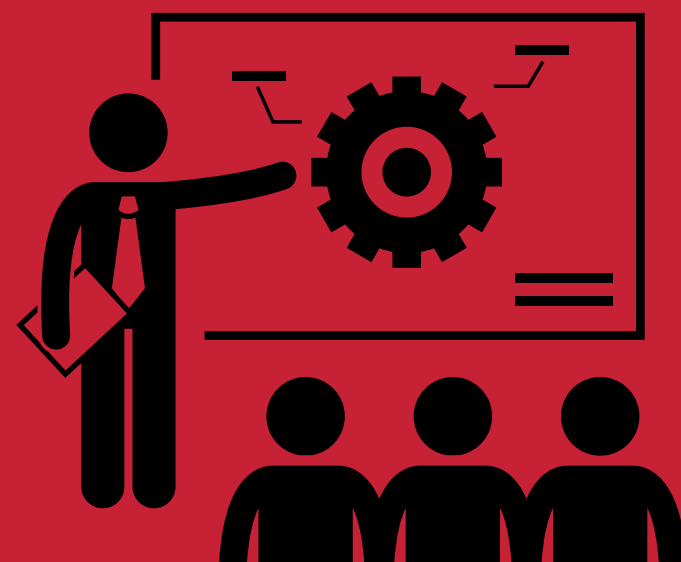

TYPES OF HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS

There are 500 officially recognised institutions in 165 towns and cities through Germany

Universities in Germany are divided in 3 categories

Technical University

- Bachelors/Masters offered
- Mainly theoretical knowledge
- Research oriented work
- Faculties like Education, Engineering, Science, Law, Medicine, Social Sciences, Business Management are taught

University of Applied Sciences

- Mainly Bachelors offered
- Very few universities offer Masters also
- Mainly practical knowledge
- Application oriented work
- Excellent job opportunities available due to close tie ups to industries

Colleges of Art, Film & Music

- Artistic courses such as music, architecture, dance, drama, etc
- Directors, cinematographers, screenwriters etc are trained
- For admission a specific talent needs to be demonstrated

PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES IN GERMANY



BACHELORS (3 YEARS)

- 13 Years of full-time education
- Foundation year in Germany / 1st year UG Degree completion in India
- 80-85% or above in grade 10/ 12
- IELTS - 6.5, no less than 6
- German Language: B2 Level proficiency



MASTERS (2 YEARS)

- 16 Years of full-time education
- 70%-75% or above academically
- IELTS - 6.5, no less than 6
- TOEFL: 87 and above / GRE: 310+
- Basic level German (increases chance of admission)



TUITION FEES IN PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES



Generally there are no tuition fees in most universities.



Yet some institutions do charge a nominal amount of approximately 200 – 500 Euros per Semester which are termed as social contributions.

BACHELORS (3 YEARS)

- 12 Years of full-time education
- 60–65% or above in grade 10/ 12
- IELTS – 6.5, no less than 6
- SAT for Jacobs University (1200)
- Tuition Fees: Approx 1000 – 15000 Euros



MASTERS (2 YEARS)

- 15 Years of full-time education
- 60%–65% or above in Bachelors
- IELTS – 6.5, no less than 6
- Tuition Fees: Approx 7000 – 15000 Euros

If you take a job as a student assistant or research assistant at your university, this is usually not counted in your limit. You must notify the Alien Registration Office if you take up this type of work



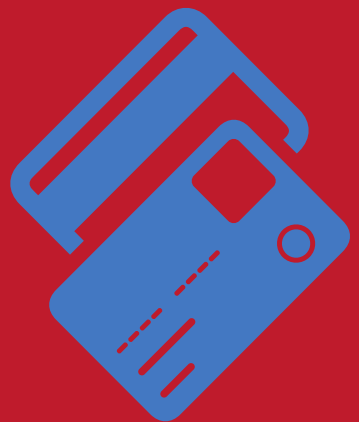
POST STUDY WORK IN GERMANY



Students from non-EU countries who wish to work in Germany after graduating can extend their residence permit for up to 18 months to find work relating to their studies.



The 18 months begin as soon as you receive your final exam results, so you should start looking for employment during your final semester. In these 18 months, you can work as much as you like and take up any kind of employment to support yourself.



As soon as you've found a job role you'd like to accept, you should apply for a German residence permit or EU Blue Card (similar to the US Green Card). You can remain in Germany while your application is pending.

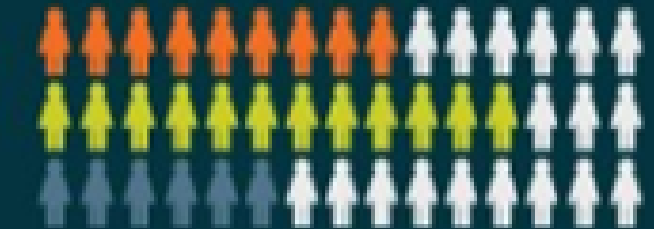

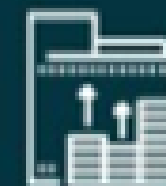

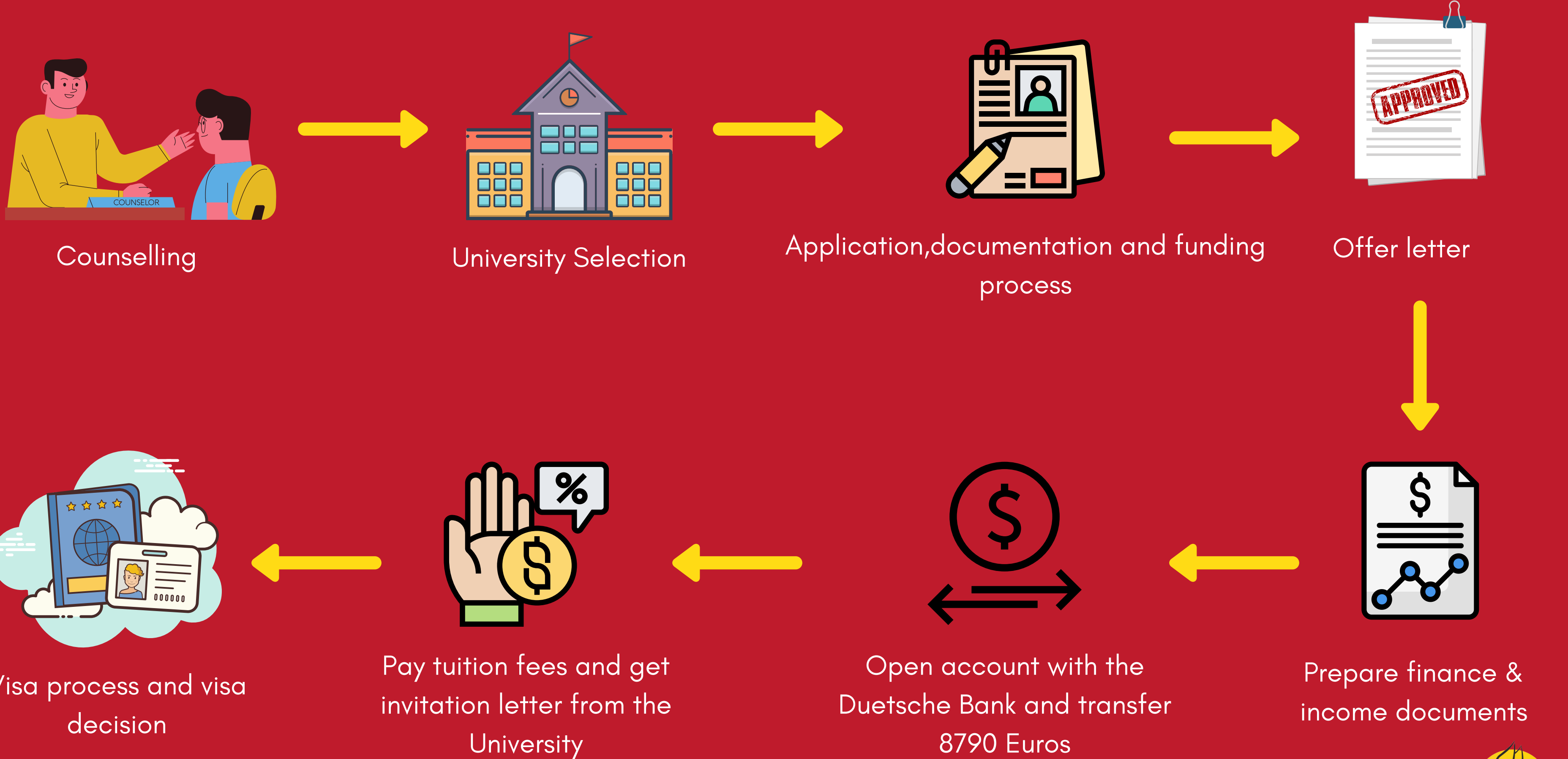
