



### Most Popular Institutions for International Students (Top 10)







## WORKING WHILE STUDYING IN U.S.



### ON-CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT

- 20hrs a week during study
- 40 hrs a week during holidays

Students can work in positions like a teaching assistant, research assistant, food services, library, event coordinator, laboratory assistant, etc.




#### **OFF-CAMPUS EMPOLYMENT**

## OPT - OPTIONAL PRACTICAL TRAINING


Eligible student may request OPT in order to be employed in a position related to the major area of study.

#### 12/36 months of OPT available after each degree level completion

- Students who have pursued STEM Degree in US get an opportunity to spend 36 months in US after their study.
- This period of 36 months is reduced to 12 months in case of students who have done management studies in US. This benefit is available under the scheme called Optional Practical Training (OPT).



## EXCEPTIONS FOR MASTERS PROGRAMS

- 15 (12+3) years are also acceptable
- 3years of Bachelors degree acceptable for admissions into Masters for Computer Science, MBA & Public Healthcourses & other programs through Pathway with a few universities.
- Admissions without GRE/GMAT scores possible with several universities.
- Students with less TOEFL/IELTS can get admission through Pathway or English as second language program.


