



### WORLD'S LARGEST EXPORTER


The foundation of New Zealand's economy is exporting agricultural commodities such as dairy products, meat, forest products, fruit and vegetables, and wine

New Zealand is famous for its national rugby team, its indigenous Maori culture and its picturesque landscape




## MAP OF NEW ZEALAND

## TYPES OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

### **UNIVERSITIES**

There are only 8 government funded universities in NZ providing UG & PG Degrees

# INSTITUTES OF TECHNOLOGY AND POLYTECHNIC

A popular option is to study at one of the 16 govt funded ITPs. They offer vocational as well academic based course options

## PRIVATE TRAINING ESTABLISHMENTS

These offer courses in a diverse range of subjects like arts, hospitality, computer studies, secreterial studies, quality management, eco tourism, etc

### **EDUCATION SYSTEM**

### UG DIPLOMAS (2 YEARS)

#### Requirements

- University: N/A
- ITPs: 50% and above in Grade 12
- IELTS: 6.0, no less than 5.5

## BACHELOR DEGREE (3 YEARS)

#### Requirements

- University: 75% and above in Grade 12
- ITPs: 50% and above in Grade 12
- IELTS: 6.0, no less than 5.5

### GRADUATE DIPLOMA (1 YEAR)

#### Requirements

- University: 55% and above in Grade 12
- ITPs: 50% and above in Grade 12
- IELTS: 6.0, no less than 5.5

### PG DIPLOMA (1 YEAR)

#### Requirements

- University: 60% and above in Grade 12
- ITPs: 60% and above in Grade 12
- IELTS: 6.0, no less than 5.5

## MASTERS DEGREE (1/2 YEARS)

#### Requirements

- University: 60%-75%
  and above in Grade
  12
- ITPs: 60% and above in Grade 12
- IELTS: 6.5, no less than 6.0










